Blasphemy of the Holy Spirit

Bible Classes for All

In Mark 3:22-30, the Pharisees accuse Jesus of casting out demons by the power of Beelzebul, the prince of demons. They were attributing the power of the Holy Spirit to being demonic, and thus speaking evil of the Holy Spirit. Jesus warns them that they are in danger of committing an unforgivable sin.

Jesus said, "Truly, I say to you, all sins will be forgiven the children of man, and whatever blasphemies they utter, but whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit never has forgiveness, but is guilty of an eternal sin" (Mark 3:28-29).

From the context, obviously calling a work of the Holy Spirit demonic or evil is blasphemy of the Holy Spirit because that is what the Pharisees were implying. Jesus was casting out demons by the power of the Holy Spirit and they were slandering the work of the Spirit by saying it was by the power of demons. It is not clear if Jesus was telling them they had committed the sin in question or were just in danger of crossing that line.

I believe denying the work of the Holy Spirit today also runs a danger of being blasphemy of the Holy Spirit as it denies His sanctifying and renewing work in Christians. We need to be careful we don't find ourselves speaking against the work of the Spirit.

I do not believe this speaks to a single rash utterance against the work of the Spirit, but rather a continual denial of His work. The sin cannot be forgiven because the person is denying the opportunity to receive the work of sanctification necessary to be forgiven and transformed. It is less about the single action and more about a continual rejecting of the Spirit's work.
